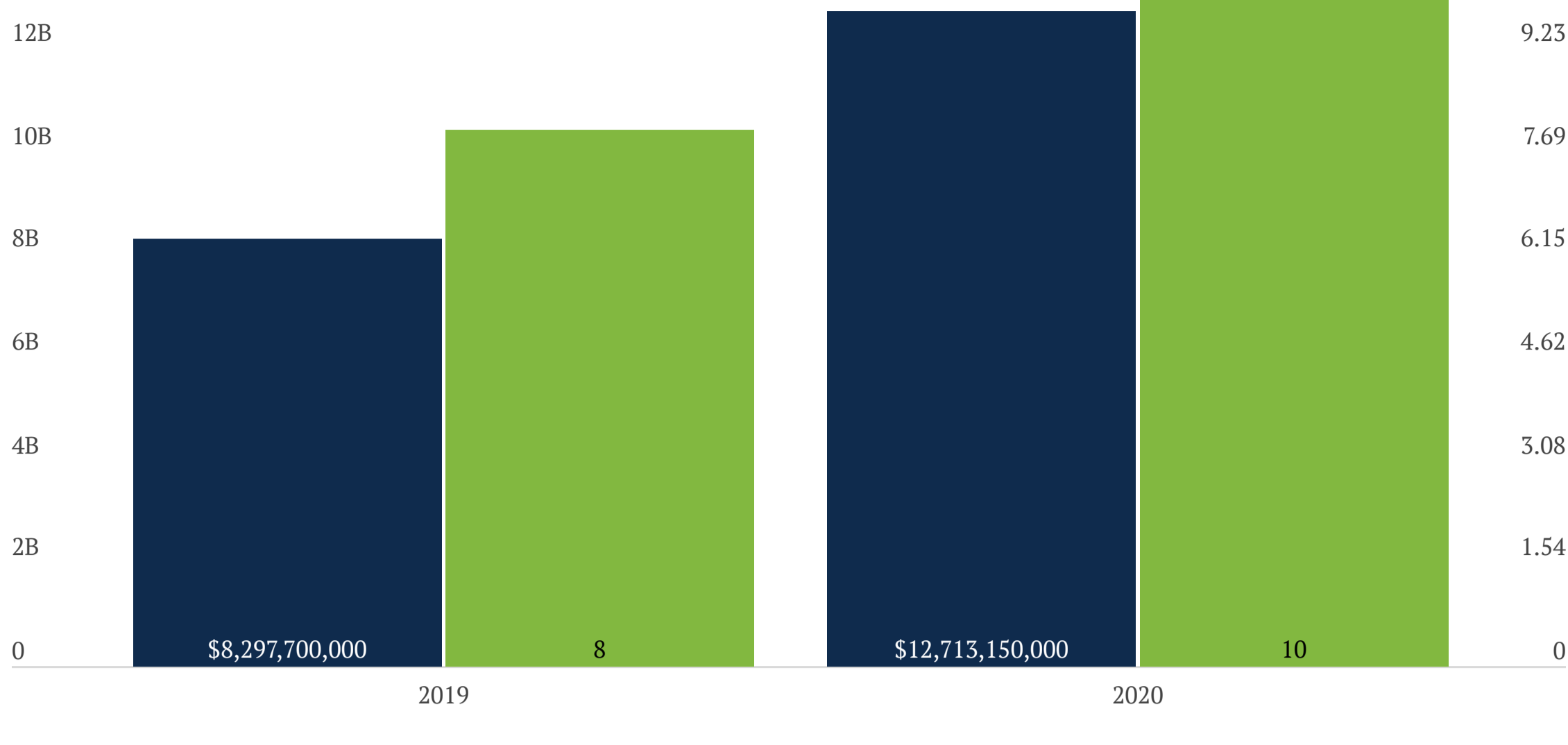


# U.S. Foreign Military Sales Notifications in 2020

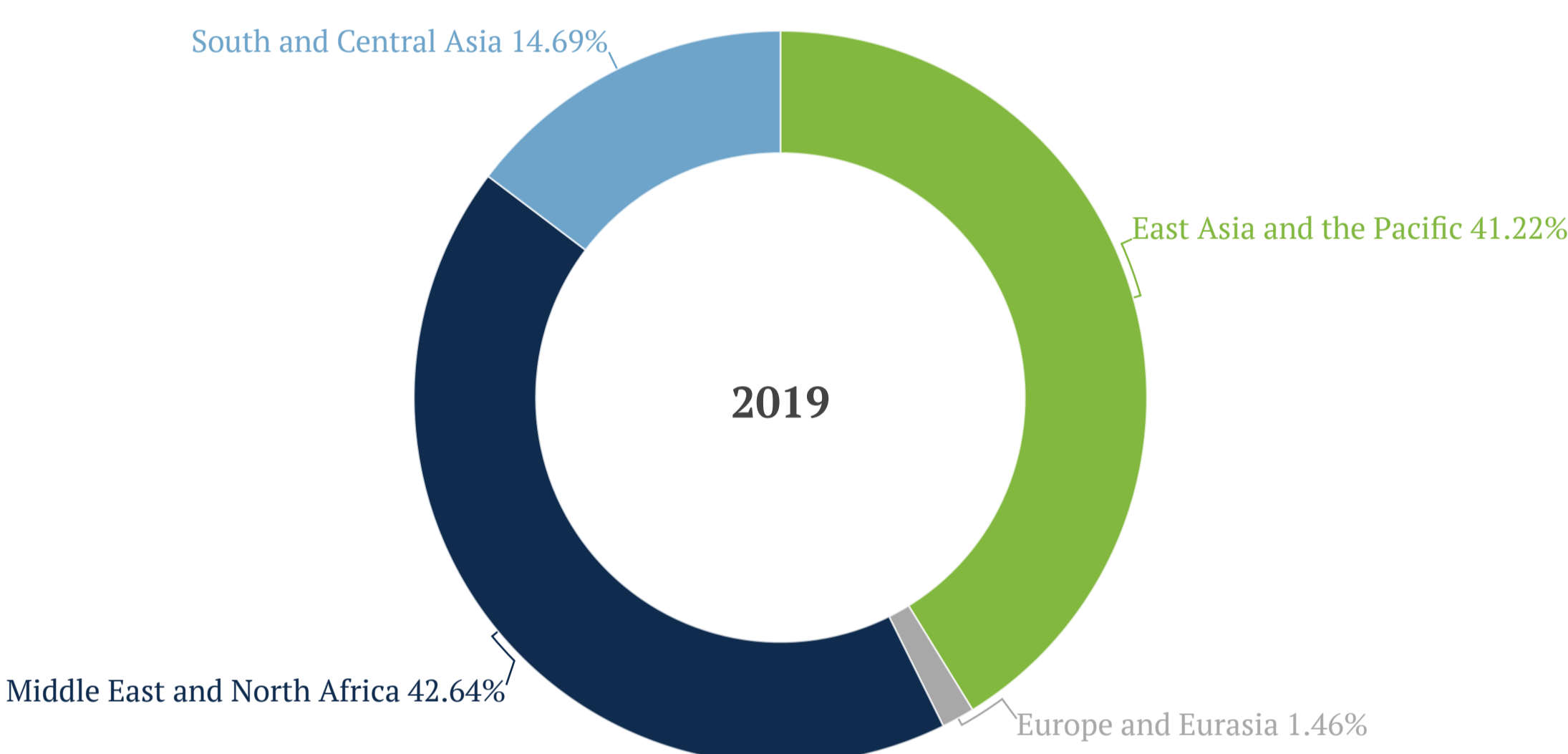

## 2020 Arms Sales Notification Recipients So Far



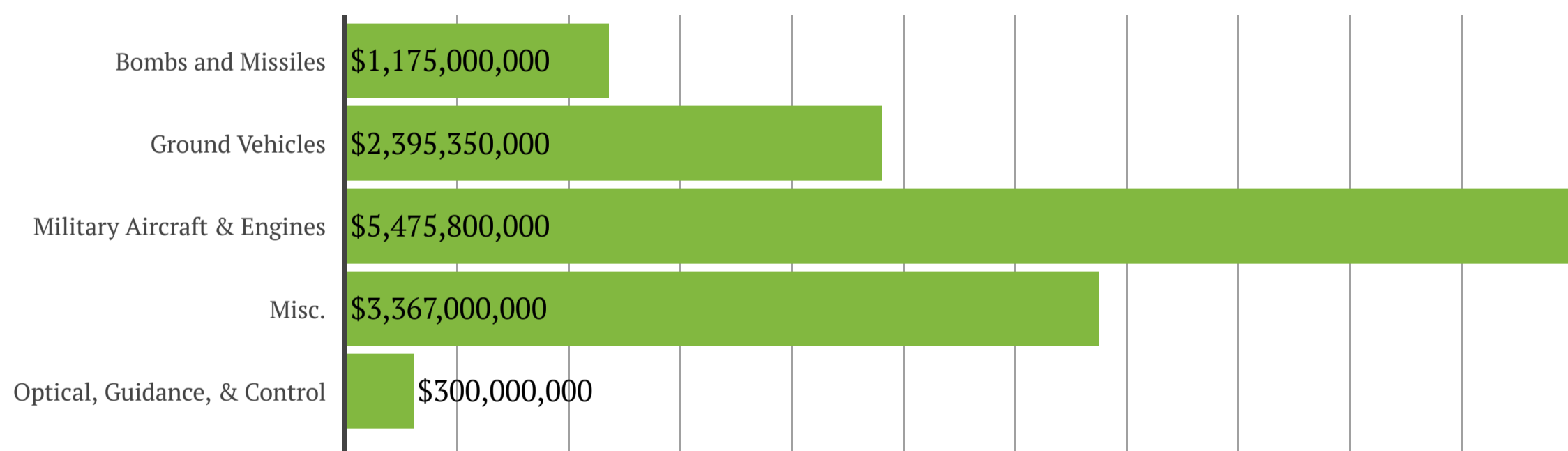
