## Country Profile: Lebanon

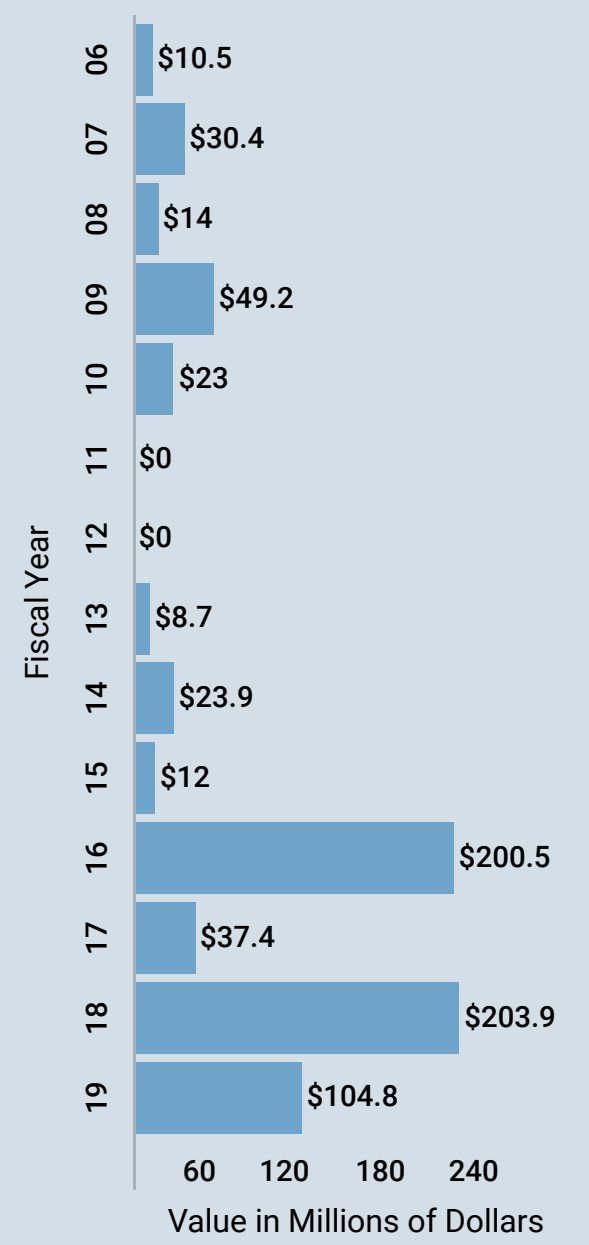
**PROGRAM:** FY 2019 Department of Defense Section 333 Building Partner Capacity

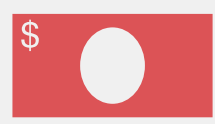

## The 4th Land Border Regiment

The 4th Land Border Regiment, announced in 2015, is the youngest of Lebanon's four border control units. It was founded to protect previously underserved sections of the Lebanon-Syria border between the towns of Aarsal & Masnaa, approximately 100km



or 25% of the border, against ISIS incursions. It is more generally meant to prevent spillover from conflict in Syria. You can find more info on security aid to Lebanon on our website.
