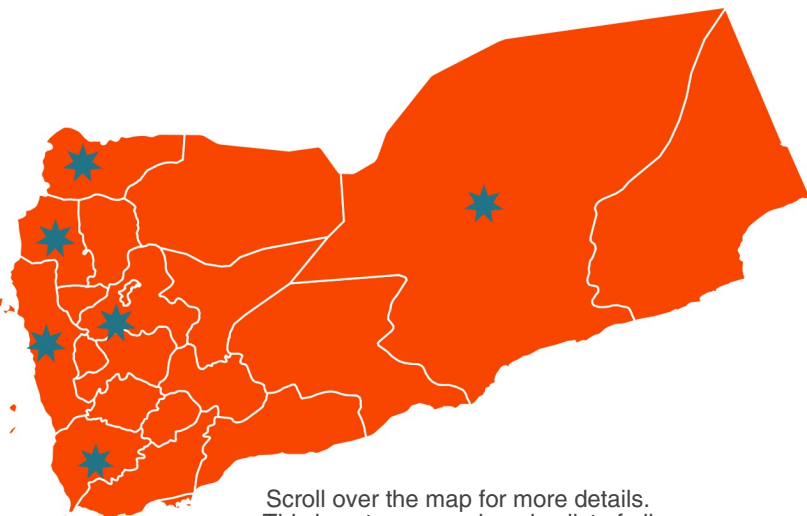

Direct U.S. Action in Saudi-Led Coalition

- > Flown over 700 air-to-air refueling sorties
- > Assist with target identification
- > Logistics and intelligence support
- > Search and rescue support
